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Platform Dashboard

The Platform Dashboard provides a centralized overview of key metrics, such as metadata metrics, mapping metrics, marketplace metrics, and insights on data governance, data lineage, data sources, user activity, and data quality.

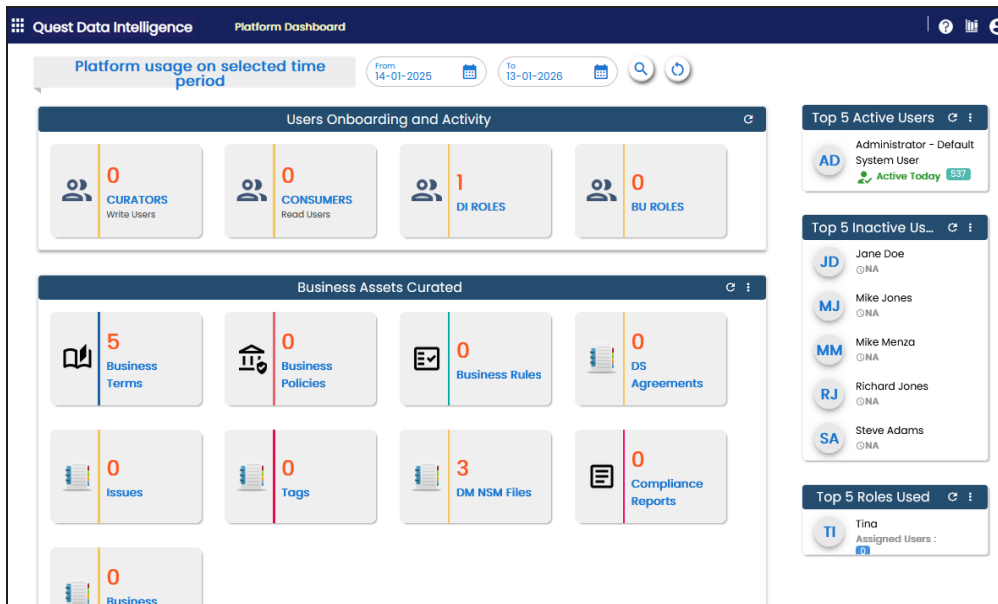
The dashboard aims to assist executives and administrators in understanding Quest DI's performance, usage, and value creation of Quest DI within the organization. It helps you to analyze the activities of different modules based on domains (catalogs) and the creation trends of assets.



Ensure that the roles assigned to dashboard users have the necessary access and permissions. For more information, refer to the [Creating Roles](#) topic.




To access the Platform Dashboard, go to **Application Menu > Platform Dashboard**.

Each card is clickable and displays information using charts or graphs that provide a snapshot of the underlying data.

You can use the Platform usage on selected time period option to filter module usage for specific time periods. To select a period, click  under From and To fields and then click . To reset the search results, click .

UI Section	Function
Users Onboarding and Activity	Displays the number of Curators (Write Users), Consumers (Read Users), DI Roles, and BU Roles.
Business Assets Curated	Displays the number of each type of business asset.
Business Categories Curated	Displays the number of each type of business category. This section is available only when you switch to Categories. To view this section, click  on the section title bar and select Categories .
Marketplace Assets Curated	Displays the number of each type of marketplace asset.
Marketplace Categories Curated	Displays the number of each type of marketplace category. This section is available only when you switch to Categories. To view this section, click  on the section title bar and select Categories .
Data Sources Activity	Displays the number of onboarded and refreshed data sources.
Source To Target Mappings and Reference Data	Displays the number of source to target mappings and reference data.
Top 5 Active Users	Displays a list of top five active users based on login count.
Top 5 Inactive Users	Displays a list of top five inactive users based on login count.
Top 5 Roles Used	Displays a list of top five roles based on login count.

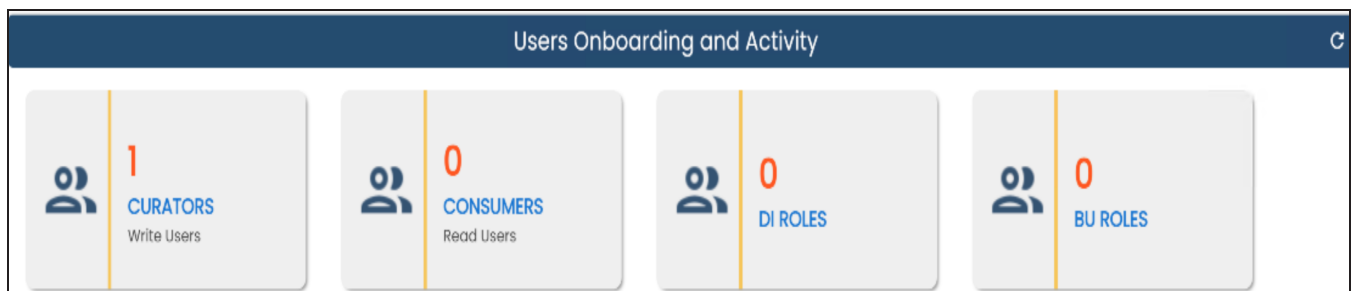

Users Onboarding and Activity

You can drill down to view a list of users and roles. For example, to view a list of users with Write access, click the **CURATORS** tile.

The Navigation pop-up appears. Clicking **Yes** takes you to the Resource Manager page. For example, the following image displays a list of users with Write access.

The Top 5 Active Users card displays a list of top five active users based on login count. The numbers next to a user's name indicate login count. For example, 509, 2.

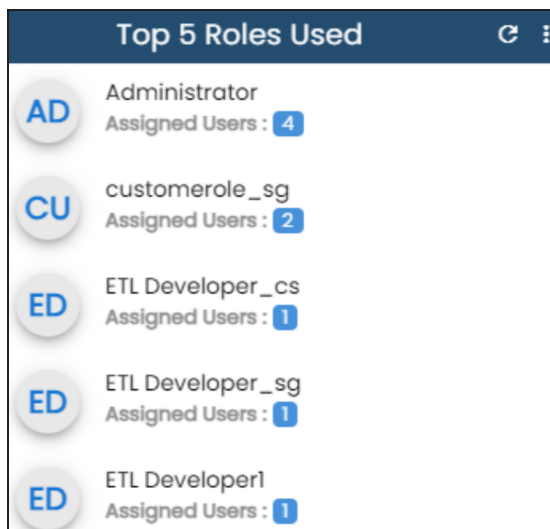
Top 5 Inactive Users

The Top 5 Inactive Users card displays a list of top five inactive users based on login count.



Top 5 Roles Used

The Top 5 Roles Used card displays a list of top five used roles based on login count. On the card, the number indicates how many users are assigned roles.




You can manage the displayed information using the following options:

Resource Manager

Refresh ()

Use this option to refresh the data on the cards.

More Options ()

Use this option to control the number of records displayed on the card. Click  and then select the required number. For example, if you select 10, then card title changes to Top 10 Active Users and displays a list of top ten active users.

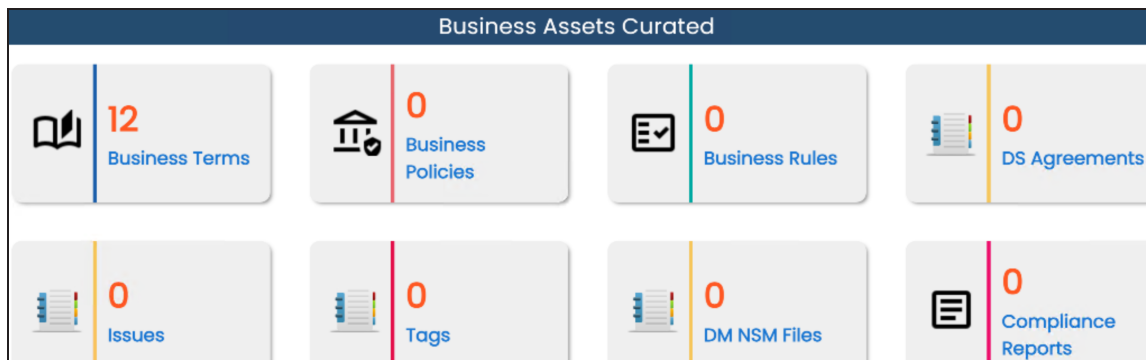

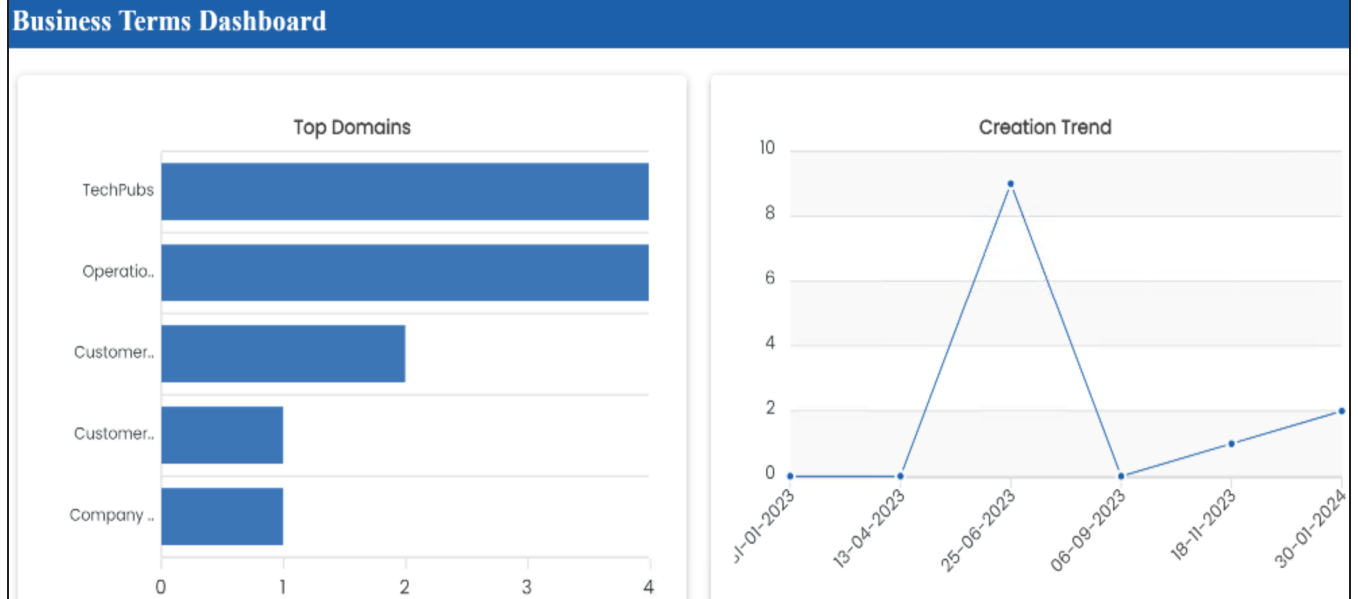
Business Assets Curated

- **Top Domains:** By default, it displays the top domains (catalogs). Hover over a bar to view the total number of assets under a domain.
- **Creation Trend:** It displays month-wise asset creation trend based on the number of assets.

You can switch the card to view the business categories curated during the selected period.

To switch to categories, click  and then click **Categories**.

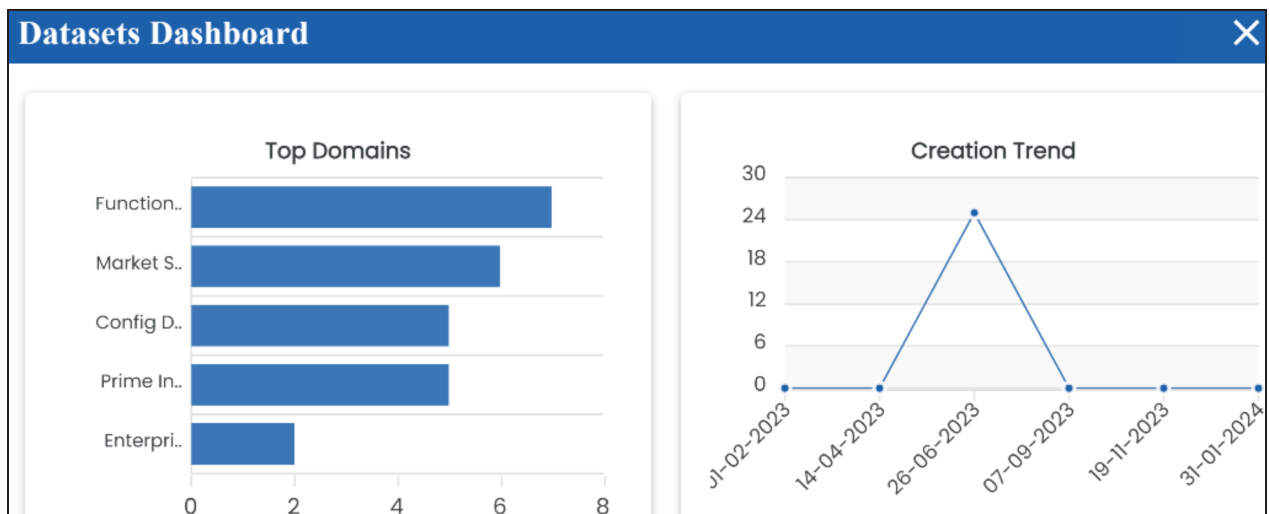

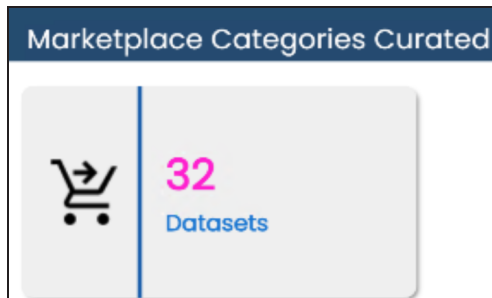

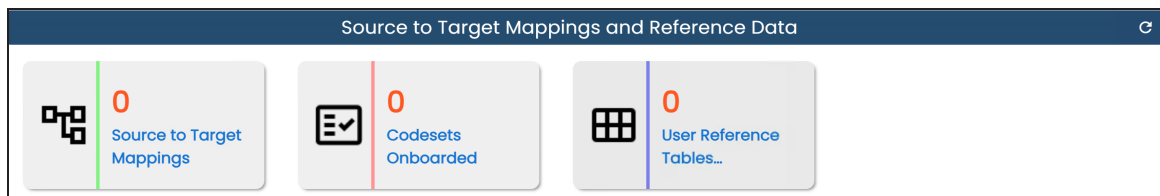
